

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC NOTICE

FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians Order
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14
Public Footpath No. 2 In the Community of Sealand

The Flintshire County Council hereby intends not sooner than 7 days from the 27th December 2012 to make an Order which will prohibit pedestrians from using that section of Public Footpath No. 2 in the Community of Sealand from a point at NGR 33690 36589 65 metres west from the Saltney Ferry footbridge to a point at NGR 33702 36582 80 metres east from the Saltney Ferry footbridge.

The reason for the closure is to facilitate the construction of a new flood defence wall on top of the existing embankment either side of Saltney Ferry footbridge by Environment Agency Wales.

It is anticipated that the Order will come into force on the 14th January 2013. The closure is expected to last for a minimum of 10 weeks, or until the earlier completion of the works, subject to a maximum period of 6 months until 14th July 2013.
