

CTC Cymru Treasure Hunt and Map Reading Competitions



Starting from Crossroads Cafe, Trefnant

Map 116 Grid ref: 053706

Have an enjoyable day out and take part in one or both of these events. The competitions will start from the Crossroads Cafe in Trefnant; off the A525, about 50 yards from the lights. There is free parking space available. The cafe will be open from 9 o'clock and refreshments can be purchased before, between and after the events.

The rides should be ridden for fun, but they are also eligible for points as 'E' events in the CTC Tourist Competition as long as people compete as individuals (rather than teams).

Treasure Hunt

Start between 9.30 and 10.00am

Entry fee £1.50 per person

The Treasure Hunt will be about 15 miles long (although you may ride further if you turn back to look for clues) and there will be approximately 35 questions to answer along the route. Those who wish to enter the Map Reading competition need to be back in time to start at 1 o'clock; other entrants have until mid afternoon to complete the course so they can ride at a leisurely pace and stop as they wish on the way round.

Riders who want the ride to count for Tourist Competition points must ride as individuals. There will also be a team competition for pairs of riders; juniors and adults can ride together as a team; tandems count as a team.

Map Reading Competition

Start at 1.00pm

Entry fee £1.50

Details of the controls to be visited worth varying points will be given out at the start of the competition. Each competitor will have to work out their own route and visit the controls to try to accumulate the

maximum number of points. After a 15 minute route planning session there will be of two hours riding to visit the controls; riders who return late will lose points.

GPS equipment is not allowed. Riders must compete as individuals.

In addition to the equipment required for a normal ride, remember to bring:

- Map 116
- A pen
- Reading glasses?
