

Touring competition events

Public Transport

Rhyl Station is on the main North Wales line from Chester to Holyhead. It is approximately 19 miles down from the valley from the Rugby Club. Wrexham Station is a similar distance but the cycling to Ruthin involves climbing up to the Llandegla Moors.

Ruthin Rugby Club

Welcome to Ruthin Rugby Club

Ruthin lies in the Vale of Clwyd.

It is a small rural town with plenty of amenities. The Rugby club offers 24hr access to facilities including a small kitchen.

The rides can be easy along the Vale of Clwyd or more challenging across the moors of Denbighshire or over the Berwyn Mountains. The imposing Denbigh Castle is worth a visit.

The Club is just south of the town on the A494 road GR 118578 OS map116

There are no meals available at the club, but there are a variety of eating places in town within easy walking distance.



What's On

The programme this year will again be for 4 full days. Camping is available from 16.00 hrs on the Thursday, so you can make an early start on the Friday. The Festival ends on the Monday but you can stay on until Tuesday morning if you wish.

All participants will receive a list of rides on arrival at the Festival site. This will cover 4 rides per day, from short family rides to the more arduous 70 mile rides into the surrounding hills. The routes are primarily on lanes with little traffic.

Those wishing to explore off road are also catered for, as there will be rides to explore even more remote areas.



Registration & Accommodation

In order to guarantee your place, registration costs just £15.00 per adult and £2.00 per child under 16 or FT student under 21. This covers the cost of organising and publishing the event and provides you with the route sheets. The registration fee is non refundable.



If you wish to camp at the Festival site, the cost is £30.00 per pitch for the first adult for the 5 nights. If there are more in the same tent it will cost £16.00 per

additional person. Children under 16 are free if registered and sharing the same tent. Motor homes / caravans £35.00 and £20.00 respectively.

Those not staying for the 5 nights will be charged at a rate of £7.00 per night. Additional adults, same tent, are charged at the rate of £4.00 per night. Motor Homes/Caravans £8 and £5, respectively.
